DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR FALL 2009 SESSION CITIZEN'S COLLEGE

The District Attorney's Office is currently accepting applications for the Fall, 2009 Citizens' College course. This free nine week program provides an in-depth understanding of the legal system and the District Attorney's role in that process. Accepted applicants will gain insight into the complex and varied roles of the District Attorney's Office, the functioning of many specialized programs in our judicial system, and an understanding of criminal proceedings from the time of arrest to post conviction motions.

In addition, students will learn about alternative routes in the judicial process and resources available to victims of crime. This course is recommended for any citizen who would like insight into the practical proceedings of the 4th Judicial District Attorney's Office.

Classes will be held on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 to 9:00. The session will begin September 9, 2009 with a registration deadline of August 1, 2009.
