Colorado Springs Police Department Gold Hills Division began using Body Worn Cameras (BWCs) with 65 of their patrol officers today, Monday, September 19, 2016. Our office will begin releasing the BWC footage upon requests for Discovery, by forwarding a "link" to Defense Counsel using the CDAC eDiscovery Program. The Discovery packets the Office of the District Attorney uploads to the eDiscovery website will provide you with instant email notifications of the available Discovery, and prompt you to log in and access your discoverable documents.

It is important that you register to receive your Discovery through the CDAC eDiscovery Program by going to the website: <https://ediscovery.state.co.us>. If you have not already registered, please do so as soon as possible. If you have registered with any District Attorney's Office in Colorado, you can download your Discovery from all Districts that are now using this eDiscovery system.

Detailed instructions are attached to this letter. Defense (ADC, Public Defenders and Private Defense Attorneys) will have the convenience of downloading most Discovery materials as soon as they are received and processed by our office. There will be some voluminous multimedia that will still have to be picked up from our office.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation. Our overall goal is to streamline the discovery process for all involved and provide better service.
