# DISTRICT ATTORNEY LIAISON ISP DRUG COURT

The District Attorney Liaison, under the direction of the District Attorney overseeing the Drug Court Intensive Supervised Probation (ISP), will attend staff meetings, work with the ISP Probation Officer, therapist as well as interacting with defense attorneys as drug cases are reviewed for fulfillment of prescribed requirements. The District Attorney Liaison will assist with evaluations of eligibility of candidates for the Drug Court program based on established criteria. The District Attorney Liaison will also determine when individuals have successfully completed the prescribed requirements, or must be eliminated from the program. The ideal candidate will be available for a long-term commitment in this position and have served as a District Attorney, have actively practiced law previously. This position would also be appropriate for a law or criminal justice student or someone with a relevant work experience area, committed to at least 6 months to one year of service.
